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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 20, 2012) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays , Wednesday, March 21, 2012, due to construction and maintenance projects:

**New Projects:**

-A contractor will be working with possible short term mobile lane closures for vegetation control on Crittenden road between Bridge Road (Route 17) and Kings Highway until 4:00 p.m. Work zone will be today through Friday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

-The Department of Public Works will have the right, westbound lane closed on Highway 58 on the Holland Bypass until 3:00 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

-The Department of Public Works will continue work on a roadway maintenance project on Route 58 between Route 58 Business and the Chesapeake City line. This project involves the removal of dead and leaning trees, which have been deemed hazardous, from the median. In an effort to minimize the impact to

motorists, lane closures related to this work will be limited between the hours of 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Weather permitting; the work will be completed within 45 days.

-Contractors will have the outer westbound lane of Route 58 closed from Kenyon Road to Manning Bridge Road from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. to provide a safe work zone. This closure is for the installation of new water and sanitary sewer improvements. The work is scheduled for completion in early May 2012.

-A contractor, in conjunction with Dominion Power Company, may have flagger operations with single lane closures on Godwin Boulevard between Moore Farm Lane and Kings Highway from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. every Tuesday through Friday. This work is expected to be ongoing until September 2012.

-A contractor will have possible shoulder and lane closures in the 3800 block of Bridge Road to conduct construction projects for the Bridge Road Medical Office Complex. This project is expected to be ongoing until March 2012.

-A contractor may have periodic shoulder and lane closures in the 4600 to 4900 blocks of Sleepy Hole Road on the southbound side due to an ongoing project. The work is expected to last until April 2012.

-A contractor is conducting work at the intersection of Nansemond Parkway and Shoulders Hill Road. Delays are possible in this work zone. The work zone is an ongoing project set for completion in February 2013.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Route 10 (Godwin Boulevard) between Everett's Road and Kings Highway until 3

p.m. This work zone is an ongoing project intended to be complete by the Summer of 2012.

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
